LIMITED WARRANTY

Who Makes the Warranty? Tireman Auto Service Centers, LLC.

What is Covered? Any manufacturer defects in parts or improper installation by Tireman

Who is Covered? These warranties only apply to the owner of the vehicle at the time of purchase and are not transferable.

How Long Does The Warranty Last?

Brake Service

- **Bronze Service: Parts** - 15 months, 15,000 miles, whichever comes last / **Labor** - 15 months, 15,000 miles, whichever comes last.
- **Silver Service: Parts** - 15 months, 15,000 miles, whichever comes last / **Labor** - 15 months, 15,000 miles, whichever comes last. Includes premium brake pads or shoes.
- **Gold Service: Parts** - For as long as you own the vehicle / **Labor** - For as long as you own the vehicle. Includes premium brake pads or shoes.
- **All Other Brake Service (e.g., Master Cylinders, Rotors, Drums, etc.):** Parts - 15 months, 15,000 miles, whichever comes last / **Labor** - 15 months, 15,000 miles, whichever comes last

Air Conditioning

- **Parts:** All air conditioning parts and the labor to install them are covered for 15 months, 15,000 miles from the date of installation, whichever comes last or until you sell the vehicle.
- **Service:** The evacuate and recharge service is covered for 15 months, 15,000 miles from the date of installation, whichever comes last or until you sell the vehicle.
- **Freon:** The Freon installed is covered for 15 months, 15,000 miles from the date of installation, whichever comes last or until you sell the vehicle.

Alignments

Bronze: Covers alignment adjustments for 30 days (Parts, if necessary, are additional)
Silver: Covers alignment adjustments for 36 months (Parts, if necessary, are additional)
Gold: Covers alignment adjustments for 60 months (Parts, if necessary, are additional)
Platinum: Covers alignment adjustments for as long as you own your vehicle (Parts, if necessary, are additional)

Heavy Mechanical Work: (Head Gaskets, Transmission Work, Internal Engine Work, Transfer Cases, Differentials, and All Mechanical Service Work on 1 Ton and Larger Vehicles) is covered for 6 months, 6,000 miles, whichever comes last or until you sell the vehicle.

Shocks and Struts: Parts and the labor to install them until you sell the vehicle.

Commercial Vehicles: All warranties on fleet or service use vehicles will be for 6 months, 6,000 miles, whichever comes last or until you sell the vehicle.

For Any Mechanical Service Work Not Listed Above: The warranty is 15 months, 15,000 miles, from the original date of installation, whichever comes last or until you sell the vehicle.

Extended Service Warranty: For an additional fee, some mechanical service work may be eligible for an Extended Service Warranty which doubles the standard warranty. Your Tireman invoice will show if you have purchased an Extended Service Warranty. All other terms and conditions apply.

What Will Tireman Do? Tireman will repair or replace any defects in parts or improper installation to the original person listed on the original invoice.

What Doesn't The Warranty Cover? These warranties do not apply if misuse, accident or negligence has damaged your repaired vehicle. This warranty also does not cover the loss of vehicle, loss of time, towing, inconvenience or commercial loss. This warranty does not apply if we are prohibited to make such repairs according to state, local, or federal law. Some states may allow the exclusion or elimination of these damages so these limitations or restrictions may not apply to you.

How Do You Get Service? You must bring your vehicle to any Tireman Auto Service Center. If you are outside the Toledo metropolitan area when a repair is necessary, you should have the repair made. Tireman will reimburse you up to the original cost of the warranted repair or the actual cost of the emergency repair, whichever is less. You must submit a copy of the emergency repair invoice to Tireman Auto Service Centers where the work was performed, mail a copy to Tireman Auto Service Centers 1549 Campbell Street, P.O. Box 3456, Toledo, OH 43607 or call (419) 304-3764.

How Does State Law Apply? This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights, which vary, from state to state.

Why Do We Have a Shop/Environmental Fee? Our Shop/Environmental Fee covers the miscellaneous cost of working on each vehicle. It is difficult to itemize each item and determine a fair charge for each one. Like most repair shops, we average the cost of chemicals, supplies and disposal as a percentage of the total repair price. The fee covers the cost of properly disposing chemicals and scrap items in addition to the ongoing liability costs.

Examples of supplies used: Lubricants, Seat Covers, Brake Lathe Bits, Floor Cleaner, Nuts and Bolts, Torch Tips, Fender Covers, Hose Clamps, Brake Cleaner, Shop Towels, Disc Brake Silencer, Gaskets and Sealers, Parts Washers, Floor Dry, Vacuum Lines, Fuel
